



Yemen Shipping and Food Stocks Update (commercial and humanitarian)

20–21 March 2018

Vessels Discharged at Hodeidah/ Saleef ports

Since the end of the temporary blockade on 22 November, a total of **77 vessels** and **4 dhow** are / have discharged cargo at Hodeidah and Saleef ports.

- **4 WFP chartered vessels** carrying 69,360 MT and 1 carrying 4 Mobile cranes.
- **35 commercial vessels** carrying 892,078.888 MT of commercial food items
- **35 commercial vessel** carrying 405,503 MT of commercial fuel and coal
- **4 Dhow carrying 638 MT** of medical items

Vessels Currently Discharging at Hodeidah/ Saleef ports

- **3 humanitarian vessels** carrying 374 mt of cargo
- **4 commercial fuel vessels** carrying 46,381 mt of gas oil/wheat/rice

Vessels at Anchorage at Hodeidah/ Saleef ports

There is currently **8** commercial fuel vessel carrying 106,988 mt of gas oil at inner anchorage waiting to berth at Hodeidah port and 1 vessel carrying 31,000 MT of bulk wheat at inner anchorage.

Vessels Waiting Coalition Clearance at Hodeidah/Saleef ports

There is currently **1** vessel in the Coalition holding area waiting Coalition warship permission to access Saleef ports:

- **1** vessel carrying 33,000 mt of bulk wheat for Saleef port.

Commercial Food Commodities Available

As of 21 March 2018:

- **750,000** mt of cereals on the market sufficient for 90 days¹
- **101,000** mt of rice sufficient for 86 days

Commercial Food Commodities Expected (March 2018)

- Some **64,000** mt of wheat grain
- **26,000** mt of corn

Commercial Fuel Commodities Available and Expected

As of 21 March 2018:

- **16,000** litres of petrol and **41,000** litres of diesel in the Red Sea Ports and an expected **108,000,000** litres of diesels and **17,000** litres of petrol to Red Sea Ports.
- **11,000** litres of petrol in Aden.
- **17,000** litres of diesel in Mukalla.
