Abstract:

In its ongoing war crimes and genocide that Saudi Arabia and its allies have committed against civilians in Yemen for more than three years, one or more warplanes of the Saudi alliance launched two air strikes at 2 pm on Sunday, 13 May 2018, targeted civilians who were on the main road in Beit al-Bazaz area, Hays district, Hodeidah coastal governorate, killing 3 civilians including one child, injuring another civilian, and destroying a motorcycle and the main road

Incident Details

The Saudi alliance warplanes launched two air strikes at 2 pm on Sunday, 13 May 2018, targeted civilians who were on the main road in Beit al-Bazaz area, Hays district, Hodeidah coastal governorate, killing 3 civilians including one child, injuring another civilian, and destroying a motorcycle and the main road. The injured person is 45 years old, his name is Ahmed Hassan Bazaz, his left leg was amputated while the killed victims are Mohammed Qasim Bazaz, Zaqi Ali Husein Bazaz and Wadea'a Abbas Jubaili.

victims and witnesses' Testimonies:

Mahmoud Mohammed Hussein Bazaz, 25 years old, is an eyewitness of the residents. We met him and he reported us by the details of the incident saying:




" The warplanes of the Saudi alliance of the Saudi launched an airstrike targeted the main road in Hays district during the gathering of civilians who were waiting for a car carry them to their direction. The attack resulted in the killing of some of them, then another attack has been launched once again on the same civilians killing those who survived from the first attack. The two attacks resulted in the killing of three civilians among them a child. I rushed to the targeted place after the targeting and saved the injured person whose left leg has been amputated. We took the injured person to a hospital in Hays district. "

Awad Abbas Jubaili, 50 years old, is a relative of one of the victims and a witness. He talked to us saying:

" On the afternoon of Sunday, May 13, 2018, the warplanes of the Saudi aggression alliance launched two air raids on civilians who were standing on the side of the main road in Hays city. The brutal raids killed three civilians and injured another. There is no reason justly this crime against humanity and civilians.

Description of the violation according to the international humanitarian law:

Legal Center made field visit to the targeted position and found it a civil place has no military presence. It is known that targeting civilians is a crime that the international law set punishment for and is a breach for the principles and values that were established and agreed by the civilized societies. The continuing of targeting and killing children, women and civilians by the Saudi-led coalition and its allies is a crime of many

that still committing before the international society who is still dam and deaf to these crimes. This will stand as a stone in front of the collaboration of the international society and its aims of preserving and protecting the rights and freedoms that will be an international precedent of aggression against the states and societies.

Center Recommendations:

- Legal Center for Rights and Development calls on all civil society organizations and international organizations, especially United Nations organizations, to shoulder their moral and humanitarian responsibilities towards the crimes committed by the Saudi regime and its coalition against humanity and humanity.
- Calls on United Nations and Security Council to preserve its remaining reputation and to stop the war and the bloodshed of Yemenis and reduce the crimes commission against Yemen I children and women.
- And calls for dispatching international commissions of inquiry as soon as possible to investigate on this crime and the other ones and to bring perpetrators in these crimes to international justice.
