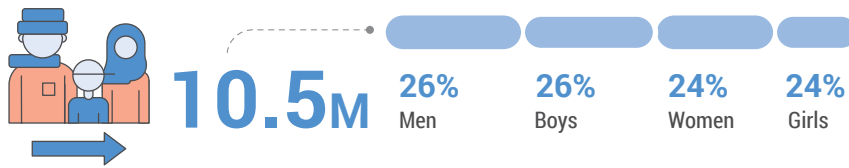

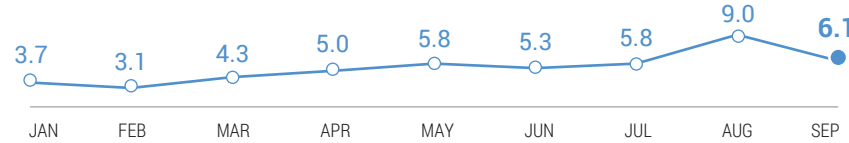

The WASH Cluster has been providing Emergency and lifesaving WASH assistance to the most vulnerable populations, whilst restoring and maintaining sustainable water and sanitation systems to improve public health and resilience. In 2018, WASH agencies have scaled up to reach 10 million individuals, 5.2 million through repairing damages, fuel and treatment support to water systems. Emergency and life-saving assistance reached over 7 million individuals, through cholera prevention and response in 192 cholera priority areas and support to IDPs, particularly from Al Hudaydah with emergency safe water, sanitation support and basic hygiene items.

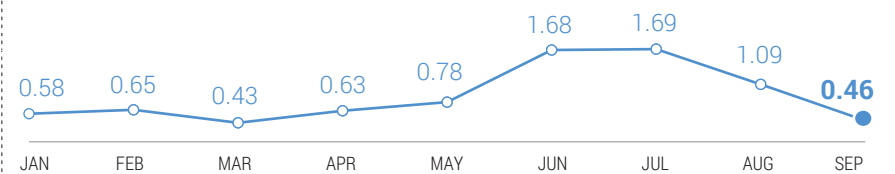
