Humanitarian Context:

Nihm District in Sana'a Governorate experienced the most hostilities. According to the Protection Cluster, fighting continued in Radman Al Awad in northern Al Bayda Governorate, as well as Sirwah District in Marib Governorate. Twelve civilian casualties were reported, 11 of which resulted from a grenade incident in Sana'a city, killing one person. Airstrikes were reported in various locations including Harf Sufyan District in Amran Governorate, while armed clashes were reported in Al Malagim and Natj districts in Al Bayda Governorate.


Armed clashes continued during the reporting period in Taizz Governorate, including in Maqbana, Hayfan and Jabal Habashy districts. In Taizz City, which is crossed by different frontlines armed clashes and shelling remained a major threat to the civilian population.

UNFPA reported that as of 13 November, registered IDPs in the Ibb hub had reached 9,576 households; of whom 7,541 households were assisted through the RRM. In Far Al Udayn District, a partner of the Wash Cluster, handed

over to the authorities a water project in Al Akhmas area to serve 11,500 beneficiaries in 22 villages. The project was established in coordination with the General Authority for Rural Water and Sanitation Project in Ibb and the Ministry of Planning.

Although there was no formal declaration of a ceasefire by the warring parties, the pause in fighting in and around Al Hudaydah City that started on 12 November contributed to a significant reduction of violence. Artillery shelling and airstrikes did not completely stop and continued to pose a threat to civilians, with incidents reported on 20 November near 50 Street around Al Saleh residential complex. Artillery shells also damaged houses in the 7 July neighborhood in Al Hali District. The Protection Cluster reported that on 20 November, three civilians were killed when airstrikes hit a house in Kulayb village south of Kilo 16 in Al Hali. On 19 November, one civilian was killed and four injured when an airstrike hit a vehicle on the main road in Al Maghras in At Tuhayat District.

Programs Update:

IBB GOVERNORATE

DISTRICTS: (1) Mudhaikhera, (2) Al Udayn, (3) Far Al Udayn, (4) Hazm Al Udayn.

Nutrition:

Targeted Supplementary Feeding Program (TSFP) in Four Districts (Far Al-Udayn, Hazm Al-Udayn, Mudhiakhera, and Al-Udayn):

This program aims to deliver quality lifesaving assistance through TSFP services for under-five children and PLW who are suffering from moderate acute malnutrition in 52 health facilities and through 8 mobile clinics. A total number of 1,370 children under 5 were admitted to TSFP and a total of 2.055 Metric Tons have been distributed to children under 5 with MAM. In addition, 612 PLW were admitted for TSFP and received a total 3.67 Metric tons.

Blanket Supplementary Feeding Program in Four Districts (Far Al-Udayn, Hazm Al-Udayn, Mudhiakhera, and Al-Udayn):

This program aims to prevent all children under 2 years and pregnant and lactating women from being acutely malnourished through the provision of Plumpy' Doz for children under 2 years and Super Cereals Plus for (PLW). In November RDP nutrition team has distributed 204.582 Metric tons of Super Cereal plus for 34,097 Pregnant Lactating Women (PLW) and 36.35 Metric Tons of Plumpy' Doz for 24,230 children under 2 in approximately 104 Food Distribution Points (FDPs) over four Districts of Ibb Governorate.

Health:

Regular Health Services in Mudhiakhera District:

A total number of (4,301) individuals disaggregated (1,152 men, 1,266 women, 556 boys, 1,327 girls) were provided with free healthcare services including Primary Health Care (PHC) and Integrated Management Childhood Illnesses (IMCI), and (342) children disaggregated (156 Boys and 186 Girls) were vaccinated. Also, (206) women were provided with reproductive health services through four targeted health centers (Bani Ali – Halyan – Al-Sharqi – Al-Afuash) which we support to provide free medical consultation and drugs prescription, basic Lab services, free reproductive services, ANC/PNC, Normal Deliveries, essential Newborn Care, outreach immunization, and IMCI services.

Awareness Sessions for Crucial Health & Nutrition Key Messages:

Awareness raising campaigns are recognized as the most efficient and effective means of communicating information especially to the general public with low literacy. During this month, RDP launched 80 awareness campaigns through 40 Community Health Volunteers (CHVs) in four targeted sub-districts (Al-Afyoush – Bani Ali – Al-Sharqi – Halyan) of Mudhaikhera District, Ibb Governorate. The planned number of targeted individuals was 1,600 while the achieved number was a total of 3,018 individuals disaggregated (976 males, 2,042 females).

TAIZZ GOVERNORATE

Food Security and Livelihoods:

Community Mobilization and Formation of Community Food Management Committees:

Following international standards in the implementation of humanitarian interventions is a main principle of RDP. As a part of the application of community participation based on the approach, our FSL team has conducted the formation of Community Food Management Committees (CFMCs) in four sub-districts (Al-Asabeh, Hadharim, Adeem, Al Zakiriah) of Ash Shamayatayn District, Taizz Governorate, through the election of 35 CFMCs members (17 men, 18 women). Women were empowered and assigned in leadership positions. During the event, approximately 2,011 individuals disaggregated (909 men, 1,102 women) from the community members were gathered.

An Induction Workshop about the New FSL Project in Dimnat Khadair District.

An induction workshop was conducted about the project of the emergency food assistance for the most vulnerable households in Dimnat Khadir District of Taizz Governorate. The project will be targeting 1,910 HHs of 13,160 individuals disaggregated 657 IDPs (129 men, 134 women, 193 boys, 201 girls) and 12,503 affected host communities (2,450 men, 2,551 women, 3,676 boys, 3,826 girls) in Khadiar Alsalami and Khadiar Albadw sub-districts.

An Induction Workshop about the New FSL Project in Ash Shamayatayn District.

An induction workshop was conducted about the project of the emergency food assistance for the most vulnerable households in Ash Shamayatayn District of Taizz Governate. The project will be targeting 2,800 HHs of IDPs and affected host communities with a total of 19,600 individuals disaggregated (3,842 men, 3,998 women, 5,762 boys, 5,998 girls) in Alasabih, Adeem, Hadharem, and Al Zakiriah sub-districts.



Assessment of WASH services in health facilities in Six Governorates:

Amanat Al Asimah, Governorate

DISTRICTS: Al Wahdah, As Sabain, Assafi'yah, At Tahrir, Ma'ain, Ath'thaorah, Az'zal, Old City of Sana'a, Shu'aub.

Conducting Assessment of WASH Services:

Our WASH civil engineers continue the assessment process of WASH services in 26 targeted health facilities in order to improve access to sustain WASH services.

Hygiene Awareness – Raising:

To help improve families' health and prevent further diseases outbreaks, RDP WASH team has conducted hygiene awareness sessions in nearly 158 supported health facilities over six Governorates (Sana'a, Marib, Al-Bayda, Amran, Dhamar and Amanat Al-Asimah), delivering many hygiene messages to raise awareness about the importance of WASH and how to practice it through daily life.

Mapping the Supported HFs in Sana'a & Al-Bayda Governorates:

Our WASH & MEAL teams have conducted the mapping process for 33 health facilities to ensure that all supported facilities with their coordinates were indicating in the Governorate's map.

Our WASH civil engineers continue the assessment process of WASH services in 45 targeted health facilities in order to improve access to sustain WASH services.

Protection:

Violence Against Women:

Violence against women is still widespread even before the current brutal conflict in Yemen. Through our supported health facilities in Mudhiakhera District, a GBV case was recorded about a young woman in her twenties who has been beaten by her husband using an iron stick. Her head and left eye were badly injured. The reason behind this cruel act was that the vulnerable wife gave a birth to a baby girl while the husband was eagerly awaiting to have a boy. As claimed, the husband is mentally ill and thus the wife raised this issue to legal authorities demanding a divorce.

Capacity Building on Child Protection:

Before the initiation of RDP Child Friendly Spaces project in Al-Qairawan Park, As Sabain District of Amanat Al-Asimah Governorate, our 5 volunteers had taken a ten-day intensive training to build their capacity on child protection. This training was held by the Social Affairs and Labor Office and funded by UNICEF.

People who are in acute need of humanitarian assistance are most vulnerable because they never know their rights. Therefore, our protection team has delivered many protection key messages through awareness raising sessions in nearly 152 health facilities over six Governorates (Sana'a, Marib, Al-Bayda, Amran, Dhamar and Amanat Al-Asimah) to help them understand their rights and save their dignity.
