In January 2019, OCHA conducted focus group discussions (FDGs) with humanitarian actors in all five humanitarian hubs to determine the access conditions in 333 districts in Yemen. Separate discussions were held with UN agencies, international NGOs and national NGOs, with 18-24 participants attending in each hub. All districts were scored on a three-point severity scale, ranging from 'accessible/low access constraints' to 'medium constraints' to 'high access constraints'. Please note, this map reflects the average score from the three FDGs conducted in the hub.

Due to changes in areas of geographic coverage by the humanitarian hubs, some districts within Al Bayda that were previously covered by Sana'a hub are now also being covered by Aden hub. However, due to lack of information at the time of the focus group discussions, the districts within Al Bayda were not covered in the discussions held in Aden, and therefore are not reflected in Aden Hub Access Severity Map. The districts will be captured in future access severity discussions held in Aden hub.
